Motion by Council Member Caffrey, supported by Council Member Winarski to approve Warrant 02-08 in the amount of \$9,442.34 and Warrant 0-9 in the amount of \$47,374.82. All ayes. Motion carried.

Administrator McConkie advised that he had asked Rowe Engineering to prepare plans to modify City Hall parking lot. He advised that they were asking if the Council would like to upgrade the work to a full-blown construction project. Rowe advised Administrator McConkie that they cannot proceed and complete the project without some kind of answer. Motion by Council Member Winarski, supported by Council Member Hindman to proceed with the construction of City Hall parking lot. All ayes. Motion carried.

Administrator McConkie advised that Reith-Riley started the airport project today and did a significant amount of work.

Administrator McConkie advised that the target date on bridge completion is November 15, 2001.
