The regular meeting of the Gladwin City Council was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Mayor Winarski.

Minutes stand approved as presented.

Motion by Council Member Mienk, supported by Council Member Novak to approve Warrant 03-25 in the amount of \$64,226.37. All ayes. Motion carried.

Hearing of Delegations

Rick Burtis was present from Dura Automotive relating to the Weaver house issue. He stated that the letter contained specifics as to the steps that Dura has taken to establish the vibrations at the house. Expected results from tests are expected back the first week of March, 2003.

Robert Weaver, owner of the home adjacent to Dura Automotive asked the council what position they take on the vibration issue at his home. Mayor Winarski stated that if Dura fails to comply with the ordinance and fails to fix the vibrations from their plant, they will be cited. Robert Weaver stated that he wished that Dura would make a more thorough test of the problems.

Officers from the VFW were present to inquire as to the road that will be going into the sports complex.

Doug Scott was present from Rowe Engineering for an update on the Industrial Park.

Administrator McConkie stated that we have received the proposal for the 2003 Progress Edition from the Gladwin County Record. Motion by Council Member Crawford, supported by Council Member Alward to not continue with the 2003 Progress Edition this year. All ayes. Motion carried.

Administrator McConkie presented the proposal from Central Asphalt for the intersection of State and Sherman Streets. It was recommended to table this item.

Motion by Council Member Crawford, supported by Council Member Alward to approve remodeling of the shelving in the vault area by L. Dan French Builders in the amount of \$2,435.00. All ayes. Motion carried.
