Minutes from the February 20, 2006 meeting were approved as presented.

Motion by Council Member Alward, supported by Council Member Novak to approve Warrant 06-23 in the amount of \$435,525.40 and 06-24 in the amount of \$22,605.87. All ayes. Motion carried.

Motion by Council Member Caffrey, supported by Council Member Novak to approve Purchase Order 148 to John Deere Company in the amount of \$3,200.00 for trade in and replacement of lawn mowers. Funds to come from the equipment rental fund. All ayes. Motion carried.

Administrator Moffit presented the 2006/2007 draft budget to the Council for their review.
