TRASH COLLECTION & RECYCLING GUIDELINES

TRASH COLLECTION

- Have your cart curbside by 6:00 a.m. on collection day with the **handle away from the street**.
- Place your cart within four (4) feet of the roadway, away from parked cars or other obstructions. If you have more than one cart, please keep them separated.
- Please call City Hall at 426-9231, ext. 102 to order an additional cart if your trash will not go into your cart with the lid closed. The monthly cost for an extra cart is \$5.25. Recycling is also an option to keep costs down. Recycling bins, instructions, and schedule can be picked up at City Hall.
- If you have an occasional overflow of trash, stickers are available at City Hall for \$1.00. One sticker is required for each extra bag placed curbside on trash day.
- **One BULK ITEM is allowed each week.** A bulk item is defined as an appliance (with Freon), furniture, television, plumbing fixtures, three cut tires, and building materials bundled not exceeding 40 pounds and three feet in length. Carpeting should be rolled and tied, length not to exceed four feet and height not to exceed one foot.
- Waste Management trucks do not operate on New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas. If your pickup day falls on or after the holiday in the same week, your pickup day will be one day later than normal.

RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Residents should place bins at the curb by 6:00 a.m. on **EVERY OTHER FRIDAY** of the month. Schedule is available at city hall or www.gladwin.org. For easier handling, please separate items and place in paper bags. If you have any questions regarding the recycling program, please call City Hall at 426-9231, ext. 102.

- **NEWSPAPER** - Do not mix with cardboard. No string, twine, wire, etc. Place in paper bags.
- **GLOSSY MAGAZINES & CATALOGS** – glossy magazines, catalogs, covers, ad inserts. No phone books. Place in paper bags.
- **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD** – No pop, beer, pizza, or wax-coated food boxes. Flatten all boxes.
- **GLASS** - Only clear, green or brown bottles & jars. No lids or rings. Rinse thoroughly.
- No light bulbs, broken glass, window glass, dishes, ceramics or Pyrex.
- **PLASTICS 1 & 2** (dimple and or seam) Only #2 plastic bottles & jugs. No caps. Rinse thoroughly. Flatten if possible and place in paper bags.
- **ALUMINUM CANS** – Remove labels and discard. Rinse thoroughly. Flatten if possible and tuck lids inside cans. Place in paper bags.
