

**PLANNING COMMISSION**  
**JUNE 24, 2008**

The Gladwin City Planning Commission met in regular session Tuesday, June 24, 2008 at Gladwin City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chairman Alward followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Commissioners Witkowski, Hindman, Alward, Clayton, Foor, and David.

Absent: Commissioners Jenkins, Darlington and Stout.

Also present: Jerry Mansfield, Bernadette Weaver and City Administrator Bob Moffit.

Motion by Commissioner David, supported by Commissioner Witkowski to accept the meeting minutes of March 28, 2008 as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

A proposal was presented from Basner Glass to place an eight foot screening wall on their property as well as enclose their dumpster next to the building. Motion by Commissioner David, supported by Commissioner Clayton to accept the plan as presented, screening wall not to exceed 8 (eight) feet. All ayes. Motion carried.

Lengthy discussion as to temporary pools and the regulation thereof. Zoning Administrator Weaver explained some of the difficulties encountered with the structures. Jerry Mansfield appeared before the Commission to note the practical problems which the ordinance did not address. The commissioners asked that the County Building Inspector and planning consultant be asked to give feedback and if possible, attend the upcoming July meeting, and until that time decisions regarding the pools will be tabled.

Correspondence and upcoming zoning ordinance review was discussed. Motion by Commissioner Foor, supported by Commissioner David to adjourn. Motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
