

GLADWIN AIRPORT COMMISSION MEETING

November 12, 2015 @ 8:30 a.m. at the Airport

Meeting was called to order at 8:33 a.m. by John Caffrey.

Minutes reviewed for October meeting.

Motion by Aultman seconded by McKenna to accept minutes as read.

There were no warrants for consideration this month.

Report from Mike Hargrave:

1. Mike attended a MAP meeting in Lansing on November 3 to discuss the ten-year plan for airport improvements. This included a report on the T-Hangers from Mike Borda of QOE. The original estimate for the hangers was \$450,000 to 500,000. New estimate is closer to \$350,000, current funds available are just under the \$350,000 mark and if needed we may be able to borrow from the 2017 budget to cover the shortage. The discussion of the ten-year plan included the weather reporting system and the runway extension.
2. Transition is being made for winter; summer equipment is stored and snow removal equipment ready for use.
3. There will be a twin engine King Air jet arriving here on Monday (November 16) at around 6 pm. It will be here for several hours for passengers to conduct local business.

Mike Smith reported that the annual Christmas Fly-In for Foster Children will be on December 5, it will last from approximately 8:30 am until Noon.

Motion by Smith, seconded by McKenna to adjourn meeting.
