

**AIRPORT COMMISSION MEETING**  
**October 14, 2010 at 8:30 a.m. at Airport**

Mike stated that as of yesterday the truck should be a done deal. Signature Ford is waiting to hear from the State and once they get the okay then they will get everything done.

Mike had a meeting with the State and Baker Engineering and the re bidding for the Fuel Farm is in progress. There are 7 to 8 contractors that Paul from Baker is going to send the specs to and see what they can do for us.

Hydro Design came and did their inspection and the Airport has to disconnect the pump from the well.

Mike stated that all of the T Hangers are rented out but one will become available in December.

Mike discussed the Literacy Council and the 27<sup>th</sup> Cub Scout Troop came to the airport and he got out his planes and let the kids look at and get into the planes.
