Mayor Winarski led the Pledge of Allegiance and the Invocation was given by Mayor Winarski.

Discussed the following:

1. General Fund General Fund Budget for the next year minus \$14,000.
2. Hydrant Rental increased \$15,000 for State St. construction
3. Water Fund
4. Equipment Fund
5. Bids for State Street
6. DDA Projects for next year - Cement work - corner of Bowery Ave. and Cedar Ave., area near the old Radio Shack, and on Cedar Ave. west of Townsend St. near the Drs. Office.

Went over the Budget. County still owes their share of \$15,000 to the Airport Fund. New T-hangers will be built next year.

Expenditures – Mayor stated we have budgeted around \$49,000 to put in new carpet etc., maybe new phone system for City Hall, also put up new eave troughs and repair the soffits on City Hall.

Bike path – Several members of the committee will be meeting with the Grace Dow Foundation, Dow Corning and the Gerstacker Foundation and possibly others from the Midland Area for more money, in the near future.

City Park – need to repair in canoe launch at North Park. On Friday, May 15th the new playground equipment will be installed at South Park. Helpers will be needed at 9:00 a.m..

Motion by Council Member Caffrey, supported by Gardner to adjourn. All ayes. Motion carried.
