## CITY OF GLADWIN TRAFFIC CONTROL ORDER

Effective date: May 4, 2015 and when official traffic control signs conforming to the mandate of this order shall have been erected.

In accordance with Sections 257.71 and 257.610(a) of Act 300, PA 1949, as amended, in order to regulate, warn or guide traffic in order for the safe and efficient operation of motor vehicles within the City of Gladwin, County of Gladwin upon the public highways under the jurisdiction of the City Council for the City of Gladwin, the following parking regulations shall be established. The establishment of these no parking zones shall cause the City of Gladwin to erect and maintain parking signs as indicated
