The Regular Meeting of the Gladwin City Council was called to order by Mayor Thomas Winarski at 5:00 p.m.

Mayor Winarski led the Pledge of Allegiance and the invocation was given by Pastor Deer.

Motion by Council Member Crawford, supported by Council Member Alward to recess the regular meeting and enter into a Public Hearing for Playground Equipment funded by USDA Rural Development at 5:01 p.m. All ayes. Motion carried.

Clerk Greaves explained that USDA Rural Development has recommended a grant in the amount of \$32,000 with an applicant contribution of \$48,000 for new playground equipment in the City Park.

Mica Schultz stated that there was a need for a sand box. Everyone in attendance agreed that the large set of equipment that was presented was what they were looking for.

Mica Schultz asked how long it would take before the playground equipment was constructed. Mayor Winarski explained the process of grants and fundraising that would have to be done.

Colors for the equipment were discussed.
