Special sewer calculation rates are in effect from May 15 to September 15 each year. Billing (July 1, August 1, September 1, October 1) during the summer months shall be based on the consumption during the months of October, November, and December of the previous year. For any account that has no history, the consumption shall have a default of 2,000 gallons.

Water meters are electronically read on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month. All accounts will be billed as of the first day of the month and due on the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month. All billing not received by the City by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month shall be charged a penalty of 5%. A past due notice will be mailed on the 21<sup>st</sup> of the month informing the customer that they are past due and face possible shut off if the bill is not paid by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the next month.

# CITY OF GLADWIN

## TRASH COLLECTION

- Have your cart curbside by 6:00 a.m. on collection day with the **handle away from the street**.
- Place your cart within four (4) feet of the roadway, away from parked cars or other obstructions. If you have more than one cart, please keep them separated.
- Please call City Hall at 426-9231, ext. 10 to order an additional cart if your trash will not go into your cart with the lid closed. The monthly cost for an extra cart is \$5.50. Recycling is also an option to keep costs down.
- If you have an occasional overflow of trash, stickers are available at City Hall for \$1.00. One sticker is required for each extra bag placed curbside on trash day.
- **One BULK ITEM is allowed each week.** A bulk item is defined as an appliance (with Freon), furniture, television, plumbing fixtures, three cut tires, and building materials bundled not exceeding 40 pounds and three feet in length. Carpeting should be rolled and tied, length not to exceed four feet and height not to exceed one foot.
- Waste Management trucks do not operate on New Years Day, Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving & Christmas. If your pickup day falls on or after the holiday in the same week, your pickup day will be one day later than normal.

## RECYCLING GUIDELINES

Recycling bins are available upon request at city hall. Residents should place bins at the curb by **6:00 a.m.** on **EVERY OTHER FRIDAY** of the month. Information on recyclables is enclosed in this packet. If you have any questions regarding the recycling program, please call utilities at 426-9231, ext. 10.

## LEAF AND BRUSH PICKUP

The City DPW will pick up yard waste on the second and fourth Wednesdays during the months of April, May, September, and October. Yard waste is picked up on the fourth Wednesday in June, July and August. November scheduling is based on the weather. All materials must be contained in paper compost bags. Unacceptable items for collection include branches or limbs, stumps, root balls, dirt, rocks and landscape timbers.

Brush will be chipped for residential properties on the last full work week of the month, starting in April and ending in October. **We do not chip for lot clearing.** Brush should be placed at the curb before the first scheduled day of chipping. The cut ends should be placed towards the street and they should not be larger than 3” in diameter.
