The Gladwin City Planning Commission met in regular session Tuesday, March 26, 2013 at Gladwin City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chairman Darlington followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Commissioner David, supported by Commissioner Stout to approve the meeting minutes of January 22, 2013 as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.

Dan Measday of Universal Sign Systems, Inc. presented sign plans for wall and ground signs for both Gladwin City Chemical Bank locations. All signs conformed to ordinance requirements. Motion by Commissioner Alward, supported by Commissioner David to approve the sign plans as presented. Ayes-6. Nays-0. Abstain-1 (Stout). Motion carried.


