

**PLANNING COMMISSION**

The Gladwin City Planning Commission met in regular session Tuesday, February 25, 2014 at Gladwin City Hall. The meeting was called to order at 5:15 p.m. by Chairman Darlington followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Commissioner David, supported by Commissioner Alward to approve the meeting minutes of January 28, 2014 as presented. All ayes. Motion carried.


The zoning administrator noted that the master plan had been distributed to surrounding townships and area planning agencies and utility companies on February 10<sup>th</sup>. The County of Gladwin had until May 9<sup>th</sup> to respond. The public hearing could be held after that date with 15 days prior notification in the local paper. It was also discussed that the regular meeting could be held the same day.

Commissioners discussed the allowable display time for temporary signs. Discussion as to the feasibility of enforcing a "bank" of days. Motion by Commissioner Alward, supported by Commissioner Clayton to recommend the following change to the City Council:

602, 10.c. to read "Temporary signs for up to (4) four special events per year such as grand openings, fairs and festivals, and announcements of new products, service, or management, subject to the following:"

Attorney Jacobson will be present at the next meeting to discuss enforcement options.
